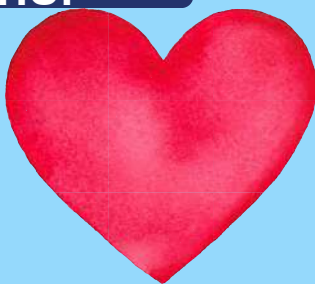

Please join us in a non-uniform day to support Benny with his treatment plan.

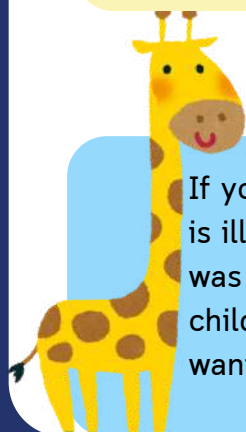


DRESS DOWN FOR BENNY
