Well done to all of our wonderful children who did their phonics screening and multiplication check, this week. You have all worked really hard and we are very proud of your efforts!

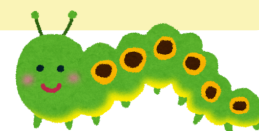
## YEAR 2 CAMP OUT
